At the regular monthly meeting of January 26, 2010 the report of the Nominating Committee, chaired by Frank Miller, III was received. President Kevin Schloerb accepted the report and placed the nominating committee slate on the agenda for the next general membership meeting, that being March 23, 2010. Eight individuals have been nominated for the seven director positions for the three-year period ending March 31, 2013. Attached is a listing of the nominees.

As you are aware, membership in the Association is by contractor entity and not by individual. Accordingly, on March 23 the vote will be one vote per company regardless of how many attendees are present from the contractor. In addition you must be present to vote in person. There are no proxies. There are no mail in or fax votes. In order to conduct a valid election a quorum of one-third of the twenty-nine members must be in attendance. A simple majority will carry.

Since there are eight nominees for seven positions, the maximum number of directors according to the Bylaws, a ballot will be developed for use that evening. The election will be conducted by the members of the nominating committee and the executive director. Once the seven directors have been elected, they will choose from among themselves the four officer positions.

All nominees have indicated their willingness to serve. You are invited to be in attendance at our Annual Meeting on March 23, 2010, and participate in the election of directors for the next three-year period. A regular meeting notice will be sent out by fax in early March.

Director Nominee Bio's (2010-2013)

Larry Josloff (*Josloff Glass Industries*) Larry has been on the board for the last six years. For many years he was the association's trustee liaison to the various benefit trust funds. He relinquished that responsibility approximately five years ago. Larry has twice represented the association at LMCI FIF meetings. *Josloff Glass* has a fifty-two percent (52%) attendance rating at general meetings.

Charlie Komoroski, III (*Union County Plate Glass*) Charlie has been on the board for the last six years serving as the Vice President. He took over the responsibilities as trustee liaison to the benefit funds approximately five years ago. During the last contract negotiations he served on the negotiating committee. *Union County Plate Glass* has an eighty-nine percent (89%) attendance rating at general meetings.

Frank Miller, III (*Eighteen Glass*) Frank served on the negotiating committee during the last contract talks and has served on our OSHA Safety Team. In addition, Frank was our association liaison representative for the LMCI FIF meetings of November 2006. Frank has been on the board for the last three years and serves as a Secretary of the association. *Eighteen Glass* has a forty-six percent (46%) attendance rating at general meetings.

Alan Oake (*Clearview Architectural Glass & Metal*) Alan has served on our OSHA Safety Team. He has served the last three years as a director. *Clearview Architectural* has a seventy-two percent (72%) attendance rating at general meetings since joining the association in October 1999.

Frank O'Donnell (*Metro Glass Inc.*) *Metro Glass* has a thirty percent (30%) attendance rating since joining the association in January 2000.

John Quinonnes (*All Action Architectural Metal & Glass*) John has served on our OSHA Safety Team. In June 2009 he was a representative of our association at the FCA annual meetings and as such participated in the glazing committee meetings held in San Diego. Since his company joined the association in September 2001, they have a fifty-six percent (56%) attendance rating at general meetings.

Al Reynolds (*Boss Glass Company*) Al has been on the board of directors and serves as its Treasurer since its inception in 1995. Previously Al has headed the nominating committee and during the last contract negotiations was the lead negotiator on behalf of the association. In 2008 he represented our association at the FCA leadership meeting in Hawaii. Al was one of our association liaison representatives for the LMCI FIF meetings in November 2009. *Boss Glass* has an eighty-seven percent (87%) attendance rating at general meetings.

Kevin Schloerb (*County Glass & Metal Installers*) Kevin has been on the board of directors and serves as the President since the inception of the association in 1995. As President he is *ex officio* to all committees other than the nominating committee. During the last contract negotiations Kevin served on the negotiating team. Kevin also chairs the OSHA Safety Team. In 2007 (Arizona) 2008 (Hawaii) Kevin represented our association at the FCA leadership meetings. In 2009, he was a representative to the LMCI FIF November meetings. *County Glass* has a ninety-seven percent (97%) attendance rating at general meetings.
